Position Summary:

Enlists & organizies Host Churches to serve overflow population of guests during the rainy and cold winter months. Trains overnight awake staff in working with host churches and serving both church volunteers and clients. Engages with the Mobile Shower coordinator and offers support, supervision & training as needed.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- * Vet & hire overnight awake staff prior to start of winter alternative shelter months.
- * Train staff on policy & procedure for overnight positions and coordinates schedules.
- * Maintain existing & develop new relationships with host churches and locations.
- * Coordinate or delegate coordination of transportation of guests, overnight bedding and supplies to the various host church locations.
- * Discern in the course of overnight activities when special assistance needs to be contacted as particular situations arise. This might include contacting various city resources such as police, health or mental health facilities or workers, detox agencies, trauma centers etc.
- * Maintain communication with Nomadic Shelter & Shower Ministry staff to resolve any needs or difficulties that may arise; provide moral support & receive feedback from same.
